

JANUARY 2002 CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE

BILL NO. CLB02-14

INTRODUCED BY: Executive Branch – Blaine Bulltail-Executive Assistant

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: AN ACT RATIFYING AND RECOGNIZING ALL EXISTING CROW TRIBAL COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS THAT DO NOT CONFLICT WITH THE NEW CONSTITUTION UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THOSE RESOLUTIONS ARE REPEALED DIRECTLY OR REPEALED THROUGH PASSAGE OF LEGISLATION BY THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE.

WHEREAS, the passage of the Crow Tribal Constitution in July, 2001 did not automatically nullify existing Crow Tribal Council Resolutions and many existing Resolutions remain integral to the operation of the Crow Tribal Government; and

WHEREAS, many Tribal Council Resolutions do not conflict with the Crow Tribal Constitutions; and

WHEREAS, a complete repeal of those Resolutions would result in a needless investment of time and energy by the Crow Tribal Legislative and Executive Branches to duplicate much of the legislation represented by those Resolutions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CROW TRIBE:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. All existing Crow Tribal Council Resolutions, not in conflict with the new Constitution, are ratified until repeal. (1) All existing Crow Tribal Council Resolutions that are not in conflict with the new Crow Tribal Constitution are hereby ratified and recognized as valid until such time as those Resolutions may be repealed directly or through the passage of new legislation.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title ____, Chapter ____, Part ____, and the provisions of Title ____, Chapter ____, Part ____ apply to [section1].


