INTRODUCED BY CARLSON (DUKE) GOES AHEAD, SPEAKER
LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

A BILL OF THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE ENTITLED:

**“A BILL RESCINDING THE CROW TRIBAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES
ACT CLB02-12”**


**WHEREAS, the Crow Constitution reads in part in Title V Section 2. Powers and Duties.
The powers and duties of the Legislative Branch shall be:**

- a. to promulgate and adopt laws, resolutions, ordinances, codes, regulations, and guidelines in accordance with this Constitution and federal laws for the governance of the Crow Tribe of Indians and for providing for the manner of the sale, disposition, lease or encumbrance of tribal lands, interests in land, or other assets of the Crow Tribe of Indians; for providing for the levying of taxes, licensing of members and non-members for various purposes; for the exclusion of persons not legally entitled to reside or remain within the exterior boundaries of the Crow Indian Reservation;**
- b. to adopt legislation, not inconsistent with this Constitution, which is necessary in exercising the duties conferred upon the three branches of government; and**

WHEREAS, the Crow Legislature has after careful review examined the Administrative Procedures Act CLB02-12 and has determined that the delegation of Legislative Authority to the Executive Branch is not necessary and as written does not allow the Legislative Branch an opportunity to exercise its duties as enumerated in the Crow Constitution, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature concludes as a matter of law that it is in the best interests of the Tribe and of the Tribal members to rescind the CROW TRIBAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT, CLB 02-12, and

WHEREAS: this Bill “A BILL RESCINDING THE CROW TRIBAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT CLB02-12 is a Bill initiated by the Crow Tribal Legislature the procedures in the Crow Constitution requiring signature from 10% of the voters will be obtained and attached to this Bill.



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED AND ENACTED AS LAW BY THE LEGISLATURE AND THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBE

THE CROW TRIBAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT, CLB 02-12 IS HEREBY THIS ACTION RESCINDED, AND

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER DECLARED AND HEREBY ENACTED AS LAW:


“A BILL RESCINDING THE CROW TRIBAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT CLB02-12 IS ATTACHED INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE AND MADE A PART HEREOF: THE ATTACHED CROW TRIBAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT, CLB02-12 SHALL BY THIS ACTION HAVE NO FURTHER FORCE AND EFFECT, AND

AND BE IT FURTHER DECLARED AND HEREBY ENACTED AS LAW

THE CROW TRIBAL EXECUTIVE BRANCH SHALL PROVIDE TO THE CROW TRIBAL LEGISLATURE A CERTIFIED COPY OF ALL ACTIONS, LAWS, RULES REGULATIONS, ETC. TAKEN UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE CROW TRIBAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT CLB02-12 FROM ITS PASSAGE TO THE POINT THE CROW TRIBAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT IS RESCINDED: WITHIN 90 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE CERTIFIED COPY OF ALL LAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS ETC., THE CROW LEGISLATURE SHALL EXAMINE THE DOCUMENTATION AND SHALL TAKE THE ACTION THE CROW LEGISLATURE DEEMS NECESSARY AND PROPER.


BE IT FINALLY DECLARED AND ENACTED AS A MATTER OF CROW TRIBAL LAW

THIS ACTION SHALL TAKE IMMEDIATE EFFECT UPON THE PASSAGE OF THIS BILL BY THE LEGISLATURE AND SIGNING BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBE OF INDIANS.




CERTIFICATION




