LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION NO. LR0212

INTRODUCED BY: ELOISE PEASE, VALLEY OF THE CHIEFS DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE CROW TRIBAL GOVERNMENT

A RESOLUTION TO COMMAND THAT THE BIA INVESTIGATE AND ENFORCE ANY AND ALL TRESPASS TO LAND ON ALL TRIBAL TRUST LANDS AND INDIVIDUAL TRUST LANDS THROUGHOUT THE CROW INDIAN RESERVATION.

WHEREAS, there are approximately 115,000 surface acres of Tribal Trust Lands and 1,052,000 surface acres of Individual Trust Lands situated within boundaries of the Crow Indian Reservation; and

WHEREAS, all trespass to those Trust lands by unauthorized persons should be guarded against and prosecuted to the fullest extent, pursuant to current federal law; and

WHEREAS, the legislature resolves that it is their consensus that the BIA must take more aggressive action to enforce the laws prohibiting trespass to Trust Lands.


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE CROW TRIBE:
